

Verification of High School Completion Status

Provide **one** of the following documents indicating your high school completion status when you begin college in 2023-2024.

- A copy of your high school diploma.
- A copy of your final official high school transcript showing the date when the diploma was awarded.
- A state certificate or transcript you received after you passed a State-authorized examination (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination) the State recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma.
- If you completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.
- An academic transcript indicating you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law requires you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.
- If you were homeschooled in a state where state law does not require you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by your parent or guardian, listing the secondary school courses you completed and includes a statement you successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
