



Notice to students applying to the Nursing Program for Fall 2020

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the following changes have been made to the admission process. These changes are in effect for Fall 2020 only.

- The HESI A2 entrance exam will be waived.
- For those who have recently taken a CNA class and are not able to test, we will waive being certified. There are currently no opportunities to test due to COVID. Students must submit proof of having passed the Nurse Aide course. For those students who have completed the theory course, but have not been able to complete clinical due to facility lockdown, we will work with you to accept you into the program with the expectation that you will complete your rotations as soon as the facility is available.
- We will be reviewing the academic history of students who have general education classes that have expired and are waiting to take the Accuplacer exam. We will be working with you on a case by case basis.

GPA requirements will remain the same. Students will be accepted into the program based on who has completed all requirements on a first come first serve basis. The Department will start the acceptance process late next week.
