

TITLE: ADMISSION POLICY AND REQUIREMENTS

Gogebic Community College offers a liberal "open door" admissions policy. In general, all high school graduates are considered for admission. Adult students may also be admitted after successfully passing a high school equivalency examination (such as the General Education Development Test.) Adult students who have not graduated from high school and do not meet regular admission requirements but show ability to benefit from instructional offerings of the college may be admitted as special students upon the approval of the Vice President of Student Services and the Admissions Committee, however, may not be eligible for Federal Financial Aid.

Admission to specific courses and programs of study within the college will depend upon the student's preparation and readiness to succeed as determined by the Admissions Committee.

The college reserves the right to deny admission to any applicant who does not meet entrance requirements.
