

**TITLE:           ADVANCED PLACEMENT**

Certain high schools offer selected students the opportunity to accelerate their educational programs by taking, in their senior year, one or more subjects which are taught on the college level and which cover the content of a college course. The College Entrance Examination Board gives a set of advanced placement examinations covering such advanced work in May of each year. Gogebic Community College cooperates with the advanced placement program and awards credit for all advanced placement courses (CLEP and AP) passed. Student requesting such credit shall have their scores forwarded to the Office of the Vice President of Student Services. Examinations may be taken at any authorized center.

Approved credits will be recorded on the student's academic transcript and students are credited with the appropriate credit hours. Since no letter grade is entered, the credits are not calculated into the cumulative Grade Point Average.
