

**TITLE: LOITERING ON CAMPUS**

Gogebic Community College is committed to providing a safe, civil, and clean environment for staff, students, and visitors. Further, it is the College's intent to ensure that its operations be reflective of a good neighbor.

Loitering on campus has resulted in complaints of noise, littering, damage to property, and intimidating/inappropriate behavior. This policy is intended to address those complaints.

Between the hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM local time, individuals on campus who are not participating in college and/or Civic Center related activities and/or business, or who are not residents/staff of the College's Student Suites Residential Unit, will be considered to be loitering and subject to criminal prosecution for trespass.

This policy further authorizes law enforcement agencies with the appropriate jurisdiction to enforce the trespass provision of this policy.

This policy is to become effective upon adoption by the College Board of Trustees and after appropriate notice/signage is posted.
