

TITLE: ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE

This degree is oriented toward the student whose primary purpose for attending college is to prepare for immediate employment upon graduation. This degree has a minimum of general education courses. Total requirements for these degrees may be found in the college catalog under individual programs of study. Listed below are the minimum requirements that apply to all Associate of Applied Science degrees;

1. A minimum of 63 credits with no more than 2 credits of Physical Education counted toward the degree.
2. At least 30 credits in the student's main vocational area.
3. Two semesters of Communications (English 101 or English 105, plus one other from this group).
4. At least 12 credits in the categories of Social Science, Humanities and Science/Mathematics with a minimum of one course from each category.
5. Related Studies - to complete fulfillment of total credit requirements.
6. ORI 100 Freshman Seminar.

Although the Associate of Applied Science degree is designed primarily for immediate employment, many of the courses in these degree programs can transfer to four-year colleges. The student is encouraged to consult with an advisor regarding transfer if interested.
