

TITLE: REPETITION OF COURSES

When a student repeats a course in which he earned a "D" or "F", the record made in repetition will supersede the first record; thereby making it possible to improve the cumulative grade point average. The student is reminded, however, that the first grade will continue to be on his/her record although it has been superseded by the second grade.

When a student repeats a course in which s/he has earned a grade higher than a D, the original grade will continue to be used in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average and the new grade will be excluded from the calculation. Both grades will be reflected on the academic transcript.
